### **OBJECTIVES**

The main objective of the project is to promote, in the food sector, work-based learning in all its forms, with special attention to apprenticeship, by involving social partners, companies and VET providers, as well as stimulating innovation and entrepreneurship.

#### **// WORK PROGRAMME**

An innovative and comprehensive dual training programme with a strong work based learning component which involve NEETs (Not in Education, Employment or Training) and young unemployed doing on-the-job training in agri-food companies is being developed.

#### **#Innovation**

Innovation is being stimulated by training the end-users in future and forward looking agri-food skills and making use of blended learning.

#### **#Entrepreneurship**

The project will include training in entrepreneurial and venture creation skills as well as mentoring sessions with agri-food professionals and experts, thus encouraging entrepreneurship.

## // THE CONSORTIUM

The partnership is composed of three National agri-food industry associations (social partners) with a network of over 8.000 agri-food SMEs and multinational companies.

Three VET providers and one relevant HEI cooperate closely with the social partners to develop the dual training programme in each project country.

## EXPECTED RESULTS

- An **analysis** of needed skill in the food sector.
- Development of a **training program**, specially addressing young peoples and NEETs.
- Creation of a **free open platform** gathering the reskill training material.
- Organization of **mentoring sessions** for young and NEETs to promote entrepreneurship.
